354114: Colin is high energy and enjoys teaching. Some of the class material can come across as biased and I feel that this is at times intentional in an effort to facilitate class discussion. A challenge that this class faces is that it tries to look at a long list of issues in brief. If the overall class goal is to introduce students to the various fields of Environmental Science it feels like we just drove past a building, at highway speed, and glanced into the windows. These quick glances often muddy the image of the topics. For example, we were instructed that "organic producers do not use any chemicals". This statement is false because organic producers can and do use chemicals. The distinction is that they cannot use synthetic chemicals and that distinction was not presented to the students. That said, I can understand the instructors position because this is a broad topic he needs to address. To explore it further would take more time then we have in this semester. This example could be used for sustainable water management, or animal production, or the issues in forestry and the list goes on. Therefore I feel that compromises in the validity of certain positions must be made in order progress through the material. The question I have for this course is, does this course try to cover too much material? Colin does deserve credit for being open to criticism of his course and for his repeated attempts at classroom participation. He also deserves credit for facilitating a class that does buck the norms of other classes on campus and gives students more freedom than many are accustomed to.

They were more than willing to provide constructive feedback and comments. They provided us with lots of time to complete our projects. Participating in this First Year Research Experience was a wonderful experience, and is a fantastic way to introduce first-year students to academic research. I am grateful that I signed up for this course. It has encouraged me to be more aware of the choices that I am making and how it impacts our environment. I wish that I had taken this course sooner in my degree as I think that it would have influenced the choices that I made for my degree.
